Rain Barrels

A rain barrel collects water and stores it for when you need it most – during periods of drought or during peak usage. It provides an ample supply of free “soft water” containing no chlorine, lime or calcium making it ideal for gardens, indoor plants, and car and window washing. A rain barrel will save about 1,300 gallons of water during the peak summer months. Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it decreases the demand for treated tap water.

Black Lid barrel features:

-  Intake screen to keep debris and mosquitoes out
-  Overflow directs water away from the foundation

-  Connects to drip irrigation, soaker and garden hose  Color prevents light transmission & inhibits algae growth
-  Easy to set up and use; Screw off top for easy cleaning  55-gallon food grade barrel
